Introducing SurfSolo multiserver VPN

SurfSolo VPN creates an encrypted virtual tunnel (VPN) between your computer and one of our **high bandwidth** security VPN servers. This tunnel shields you from the most sophisticated methods of online spying and snooping.

SurfSolo VPN is simple to set up and use, and works silently in the background. The internet speed is only slowed down minimally (depending on your internet connection and number of nodes between your computer and our servers).

Secure Surfing: After you start the VPN, all your applications will automatically send their traffic through the Tunnel, hence your Internet activity is protected. Every packet of data going out from your computer will be encrypted.

Anonymous Surfing: When your data emerges from our privacy servers at the other end of the Tunnel, it appears to outside observers as if your traffic started at our servers - not your home machine. So SurfSolo VPN, in addition to encrypting your traffic, **anonymizes** your online activity.

Why Do I Need SurfSolo VPN ?

When you connect normally to the Internet, your transactions are relayed through several servers before reaching their final destination. These servers have the ability to collect information as your requests are routed through them. The most common example of a server that can collect information about your Internet activity is your Internet Service Provider (ISP), a hotel or public WiFi Hotspot. Since your requests are not encrypted, any server between you and your final destination can "see" what you are doing.

How does SurfSolo VPN work?

You can use your SurfSolo VPN account to encrypt the Internet activity between your computer and our servers. This prevents anybody between you and our secure servers (such as your ISP, Hotel owner, WiFi Hotspot provider etc.) from monitoring your activities.

SurfSolo does not only encrypt and protect all your software internet traffic, but it also provides an anonymous and secure email account.

Some of the main Features of SurfSolo Multiserver VPN:

- SurfSolo VPN makes all your online activity anonymous by obscuring the location of your computer as well as your Internet IP address.
- SurfSolo VPN, is a secure VPN service:
This powerful encryption technology runs silently and effortlessly in the background whenever you're online, encrypting all transmissions to and from your computer. The Powerful encryption makes your entire internet traffic your private issue!
- Secure & Private Email Account:
Lets you send and receive messages safely, privately and anonymously. With your SurfSolo VPN subscription you receive a secure e-mail address, with it, your IP-address WILL NOT BE VISIBLE.
- Integrated Firewall: for maximum security SurfSolo integrates a powerful firewall that in the background protects you from online attacks.
- Anti IP leak protection: It is well known that several commonly used applications have security issues (for instance JAVA etc.) and that they often reveal your real IP even if you use other anonymising software....SurfSolo prevents any software to leak your real IP and keeps you safe at any moment.
- Secure & Private Instant Messaging & Chat:
Automatically protect your chat activity and existing IM accounts.
- P2P and TOR capable! Thus the spooks have no clue who and where you are.
- We do not keep any logs! Other 'competitors' DO LOG
- Ultra high bandwidth servers provide incredibly fast browsing.

- A Windows computer able to connect to the Internet.
- Roughly 15 Megabyte of free disk space


1.1.2 Installing SurfSolo VPN Privacy Tunnel

1.1.2 A: Setting Up the VPN:


When purchasing the SurfSolo VPN service you should receive an email with your personal access data to the privacy server. Those data are needed to configure the VPN software.

Please download the SurfSolo.exe file from the download area of the SecurStar homepage. Install the software and click on the icon on your desktop to launch the application.

The SurfSolo program icon will appear in your taskbar icon appearing. Just right click on it and choose "settings"




This will open the admin panel of the software. Where you can enter the username and password you received by email after purchasing the service.


After entering the login details, click on “apply”.

You can then press the START button in the interface (or by right clicking on the taskbar icon) to turn on privacy.



When the VPN is started you will notice that the icon in the taskbar will change its color from red to yellow and finally to green...




From here on your connection is secured. Please go to the “test connection” tab in the software’s interface and you’ll be presented with a similar message like this:



NOTE: SurfSolo is designed for your protection but we have a ZERO tolerance for ANY abuse, and we will cut you off without any warning and without refund.


If you want to stop the privacy, you can go back to the “settings” tab or right click on the taskbar icon and select STOP VPN.

This will disable the VPN for all applications and the icon will revert to red.



2.0 Accessing your secure email account

In order to send or receive encrypted emails, be sure that the SurfSolo VPN is turned on (green icon), then right click the SurfSolo taskbar and select "Mail Box". For security reasons you will not be able to access/send Emails if privacy is OFF. You may login to your secure email account with the same credentials used for SurfSolo.



3.0 Using SurfSolo VPN

Once all the above steps are done, you are ready to surf the Internet as usually but in a secure way.

It is advised to test your security and privacy by making sure all working as expected.
